EDUCATION EMPOWERED: HOW PTO FUNDS ARE USED

As we approach the holiday break, we are delighted to celebrate the remarkable success of our fundraising efforts so far this year. Your support has propelled us to new heights, and as we reflect on these achievements, we want to share how the funds raised are actively contributing to our school's excellence.

TEACHER GRANTS & UNDESIGNATED FUNDS

Funds provided to teachers and staff to enhance their classrooms with much-needed supplies and special items. From new cubbies and rugs to gym equipment and a diverse collection of books, your support directly enriches the learning environment for our students.

We also provide the school with a large undesignated grant the administration can use throughout the year.

These resources provide essential flexibility, ensuring every corner of the school thrives.

VAPA & SPECIAL ASSEMBLIES

Funding for artists to visit our school to explore their talents with our students, exposing them to a world of creativity—from dance to drums. The PTO also coordinates and funds several special assemblies such as the recent 'Zoo to You' and other special guests that captivate and inspire.

SCHOOL GARDEN & BEE HIVES

Maintenance and improvements of the school garden and bee hives, where students learn about the ecosystem of bess, how to grow food, and try fresh fruits and vegetables.



CURRENT SCHOOL NEEDS:

Your continued support is vital in meeting our school's evolving needs. Items we're raising funds for include:

- 125 iPads for students and teachers (Cost: \$45,250)
- 2 10 x 10 Shade Structures to be installed in the lunch area (Cost: \$37,627)
- 8 new Picnic Tables to be installed in the lunch area (Cost: \$26,000)
- 7 Smart TVs for 6 Classrooms and Multi-Purpose Room (Cost: \$3,850)
- New Math Curriculum aligned with the new CA Math Framework (Est. Cost: \$20,000)
- 18 Horizontal Sliding Dry Erase Boards - 2 per classroom (Cost: \$40,500)
